

Boolean - Rhyme/Alliterate

Write a program that prompts the user for two words and reports whether they "rhyme" (end with the same last two letters) and/or "alliterate" (start with the same letter).

Must match format of expected output (website, 5 example runs).

Hints:

- Create rhyme() & alliterate()
- Call rhyme(), alliterate() in main
- No print in rhyme() / alliterate()
- All printing in main()
- Scanner next()
- String endsWith(), substring()
- Boolean && and ! in main()
- Boolean && operator in rhyme()
- No ifs in rhyme() or alliterate()

(run #1)

Type two words: car STAR

They rhyme!

(run #2)

Type two words: Bare blare

They rhyme!

They alliterate (start with the same letter)!

(run #3)

Type two words: booyah socks

They have nothing in common.

(run #4)

Type two words: a a

They alliterate (start with the same letter)!

(run #5)

Type two words: aa aa

They rhyme!

They alliterate (start with the same letter)!
